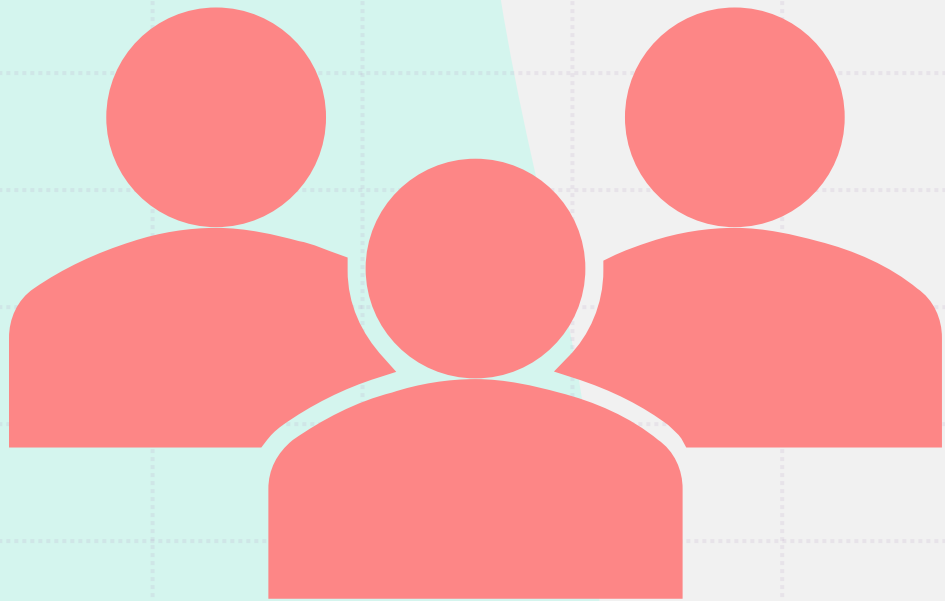

Group Presentation

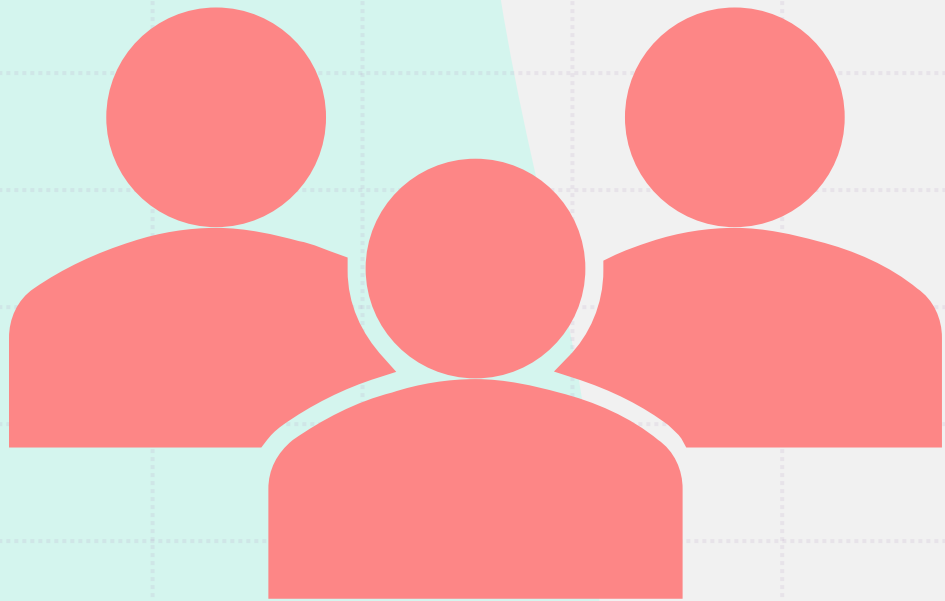
- Remember that a group presentation is a collaborative presenting effort with you and a team of people involved in a subject together. Set clear rules, boundaries and project goals together, as team.
- Bear in mind that each single person in the team has their own area of background and expertise. Create a system for brainstorming and try to include everyone.
- Ensure dissent and constant communication, practice together and agree on the design of the presentation.





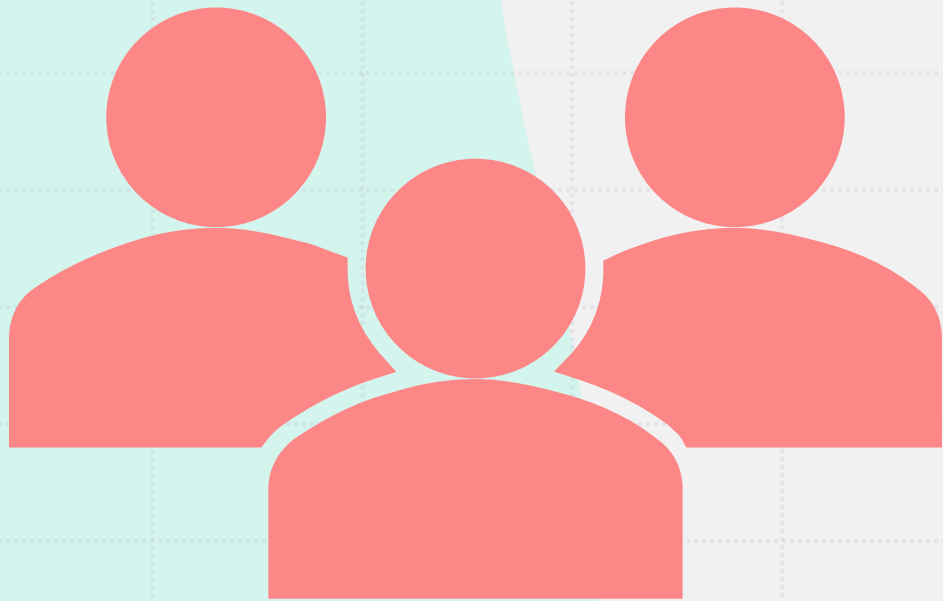
The presentation should include

- Introduce the team (group)
- Title of the protocol
- Brief description of the state-of-the-art
- Aim and objectives
- Experimental approach and design
- Justification of the number of animals used
- Application of the 3Rs principle
- Present the respective contribution of each group member



Member of the Team

Each member from the group is designed an independent task (i.e. project design, species and numbers used, procedures performed, severity of these procedures, humane methods of euthanasia, compounds and their CAS numbers or prepare questions towards the other group presentations).



Duration & Procedure

Duration of the presentation: 12 min plus 5 min for questions

- Nominate two presenters per group
- Nominate the members (other than presenters) who will provide answers to questions.
- Nominate the members (other than presenters) who will provide questions towards the other group presentations.
